### MUSICAL NOTES



We are looking forward to hearing our newly formed Bell Choir play the Doxology: Old Hundredth, today at the 10 am service.

Today's prelude and offertory anthem feature settings of the Irish tune *Slane*. The texts "Be Thou My Vision" and "Lord of All Hopefulness" are commonly sung to this tune, with minor variations to account for the meters of the texts. The melody originated as a ballad that first appeared in an Irish folk song collection in 1909, and later was used for the Irish text "Be Thou My Vision" published in the *Church Hymnary* in 1927. It also appears in several versions in the *Hymnal 1982*.
