The melody at the beginning is based on the first notes (or *incipit*) of the entrance chant for that feast, and the text is taken from the passage in the Book of Revelation from today's readings - *Dignus est Agnus*, "Worthy is the Lamb."

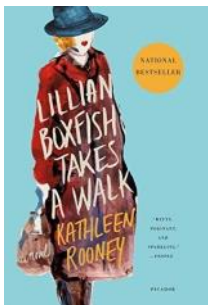
