## MUSIC NOTES 4



"Ave Verum" by W.A Mozart is this week's offertory anthem. "Ave Verum" is a motet in D major composed in 1791. Mozart composed this motet in the middle of writing the opera *Die Zauberflöte*. He wrote the motet as a gift for his friend Anton Stoll, who was the music director of the parish St. Stephan Baden. This motet was composed six months before Mozart's death. The text translates to.

"Hail, true body born of the Virgin Mary, who truly suffered, sacrificed on the Cross for man, Whose pierced side overflowed with water and blood. Be for us a foretaste in the test of Death."

You might notice that this original translation from the Latin hymn says "overflowed with water and blood" while the text performed by our choir only states "overflowed with blood". This omitted text can also be found in William Byrd's version with the Latin word "unda" (meaning whence) found in its place. The reason for the change is unknown.
