MUSIC NOTES

The offertory this week is "Hide not thou thy face" by Richard Farrant (1525-1580). What is interesting about Farrant is that he didn't just write musical compositions, Farrant also wrote many plays. Farrant is one of the earliest composers that mixed music and drama together. At the time, this was uncommon but helped Farrant develop the composition style of 'verse.' Verse corresponds to a poetic stanza because it consists of rhyming lyrics most often with an AABB or ABAB rhyme scheme. This is a prominent feature in a lot of Farrant's compositions and can be heard in today's anthem.
