***This Sunday we welcome Dr. David Saunders, Organist.***

Dmitry Stepanovich Bortniansky is the composer of this week's offertory, "Angel voices ever singing". Bortniansky was a Russian Imperial composer, harpsichordist and conductor who served at the court of Catherine the Great. He is known for his liturgical works and prolific contributions to the genre of choral concertos. Bortniansky is a great example of the 18th-century Orthodox sacred music which can be traced back to Prince Vladimir of Kyiv in the 10th century.

## VOCATIONAL DISCERNMENT UPDATE

I want to thank everyone for their prayers and support as I have started this journey to discern my future role and service in the Episcopal Church. I wanted to share an update about where I am in this process. I have just completed 6 meetings with a discernment committee comprised of 2 members of St. Michaels and 3 members for the West Mission Area. During our meetings we spent time in prayer and conversation as we listened for the Holy Spirit. We met for the final time yesterday evening and signed the paperwork that will allow me to move on to the next step of this process.

The next step will be to attend a weekend meeting with The Bishop's Advisory Committee on Applicants to the Ministry (BACAM). This will happen sometime in December. After this meeting the Bishop will decide if I am ready to become a Postulant and to move on the education and formation. I ask that you continue to keep me in your prayers as I continue through this journey.
