

This morning's preludes are taken from a collection entitled, "A Little Organ Book in Memory of Hubert Parry." On the occasion of Parry's funeral in the Cathedral of St. Paul on October 16, 1918, a group of his friends made what was described as a "small wreath of melodies, which were woven together and played." original Those pieces, along with additional contributions from others, were collected and published in Parry's memory. The title was taken from a piece by Parry himself, "For the Little Organ Book", included as the first piece in the collection.
