#### **Ukrainian Family Update**

We learned this week that the original family we were sponsoring (a family of 3) decided to stay in Poland, where they fled for safety just as we were applying to sponsor them. We understand their decision, of course. Toledo Helps Ukraine has assigned us a new family of 5 (!) and we are submitting applications to the USCIS website. (You may be interested to know that Toledo Helps Ukraine has recently completed 51 more applications for refugees from Ukraine!)

Our new family is 2 parents and three young children, 1 girl (6 yrs.), and two boys (4 yrs. and 18 mos.) They may arrive from Kyiv as early as late May/early June. Your support is SO appreciated. Though we have reached our initial financial goal, you may certainly continue to contribute. Our expenses will be higher with a family of 5. Also, please keep checking our lists for new or gently used household items needed. These lists are posted on an easel in the church hallway near our bulletin boards, along with directions about where to leave them at church. As always, your questions, suggestions, and feedback are welcome!
