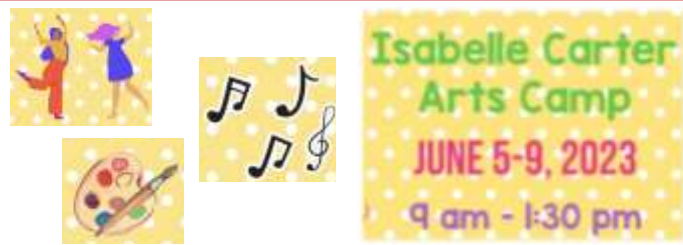
Beginning June 18<sup>th</sup>, our service will move to the Fellowship Hall due to the summer heat.

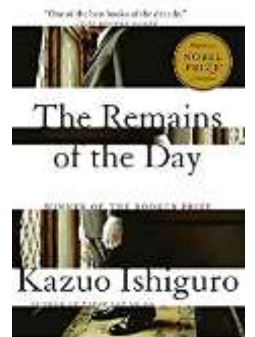
### Ukrainian Family Update
