Ukrainian Family Update

Our application for a family from Ukraine is pending approval by the US government, and we hope to have confirmation in the next 2 weeks. Once approved, we will learn of a date for their arrival. At that point we will update the list of donated items we will be seeking to furnish their home, including a grocery list, and items needed for a family with 3 young children. The weeks after their arrival will be busy with required appointments for registering the newcomers with various agencies and programs. In the meantime, we have met with others in Toledo helping Ukrainian "humanitarian parolees" (refugees) to learn from their experience. Thanks for your help and prayers for our family of 5 still in Kyiv. Continue to ask us questions and check the list in the narthex for new/gently used household items still needed.
