Our last word from the Viter family in Kyiv is to apologize for not communicating more, but that the father, Serhii, had been in the hospital. As far as we know, they are still aiming to arrive by July 1. We have taken all home goods to the house, but are not going to unpack until we have a date for their arrival. Volunteers may be needed to help when we learn more about their arrival. If you have volunteered to buy/donate items, these may be brought to the church and stowed in the conference room (in the office). Check the hours for the church staff and call ahead if you want to bring them in during the week.
