Rosie Best, Artistic Director of Issue Box Theatre, will be our guest to preview the musical “The Willard Suitcases,” to be presented at St. Michael's on Saturday, September 23rd at 7 pm, and Sunday, September 24th at 2 pm. Our own Justin Bays will sing one of the songs he performs in the show. The mission of Issue Box Theatre is to bring visibility to marginalized people. Rosie will engage us in thinking about ourselves, too, and what our “suitcase” might contain if we were swept up, as the characters in “The Willard Suitcases” were, when they were hospitalized in the Willard State Hospital in the 19th and 20th centuries.
