Ukrainian Family Update

This is the season of waiting, keeping our lamps burning, regarding the 6 Ukrainian beneficiaries we still hope to sponsor through the US Humanitarian Parole Program. We applied August 12th and the applications are still pending approval. We hear varying reports from other sponsor groups in Toledo, but nearly all say the wait time has been much longer for them, too, than earlier in the year. We have found no way to inquire directly to USCIS. We have asked Rep. Marcy Kaptur's office to look into it, which they are doing. Currently, the Humanitarian Parole program, along with other aid to Ukraine, is being challenged in Congress, according to news reports. On the positive side, we've had email contact with our adult applicants, who responded immediately & were happy to be in contact and affirmed that they are safe. Also, the housing we secured for these 2 family groups remains available and willing to wait for awhile. If you have questions, let us know. And pray for our applicants in Ukraine: Alina, Dariia, Hanna, and their children.
