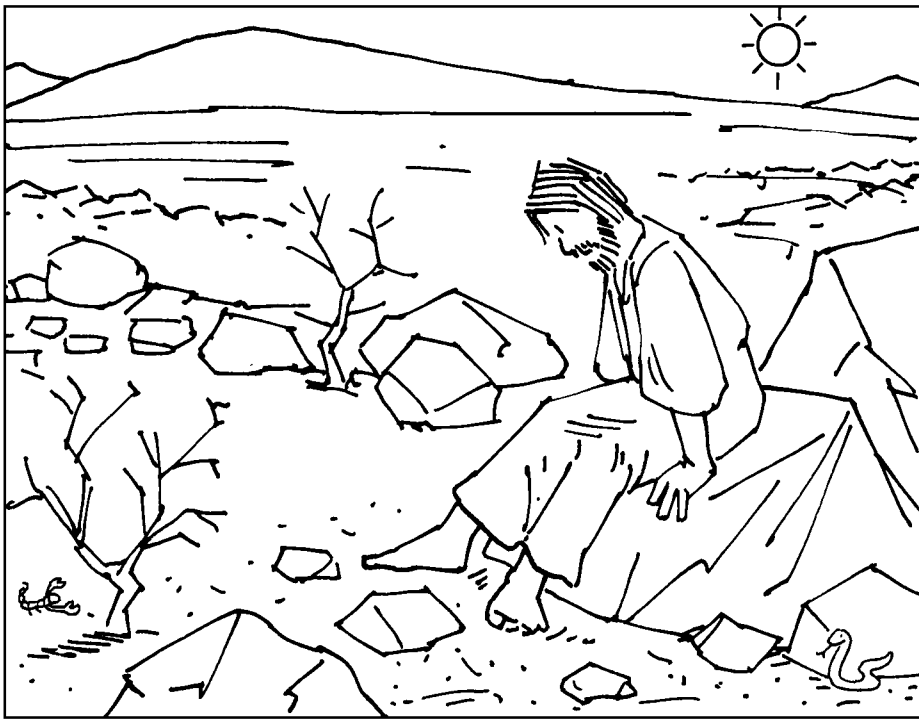
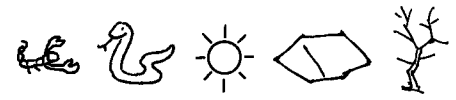

He ate nothing and was tempted.

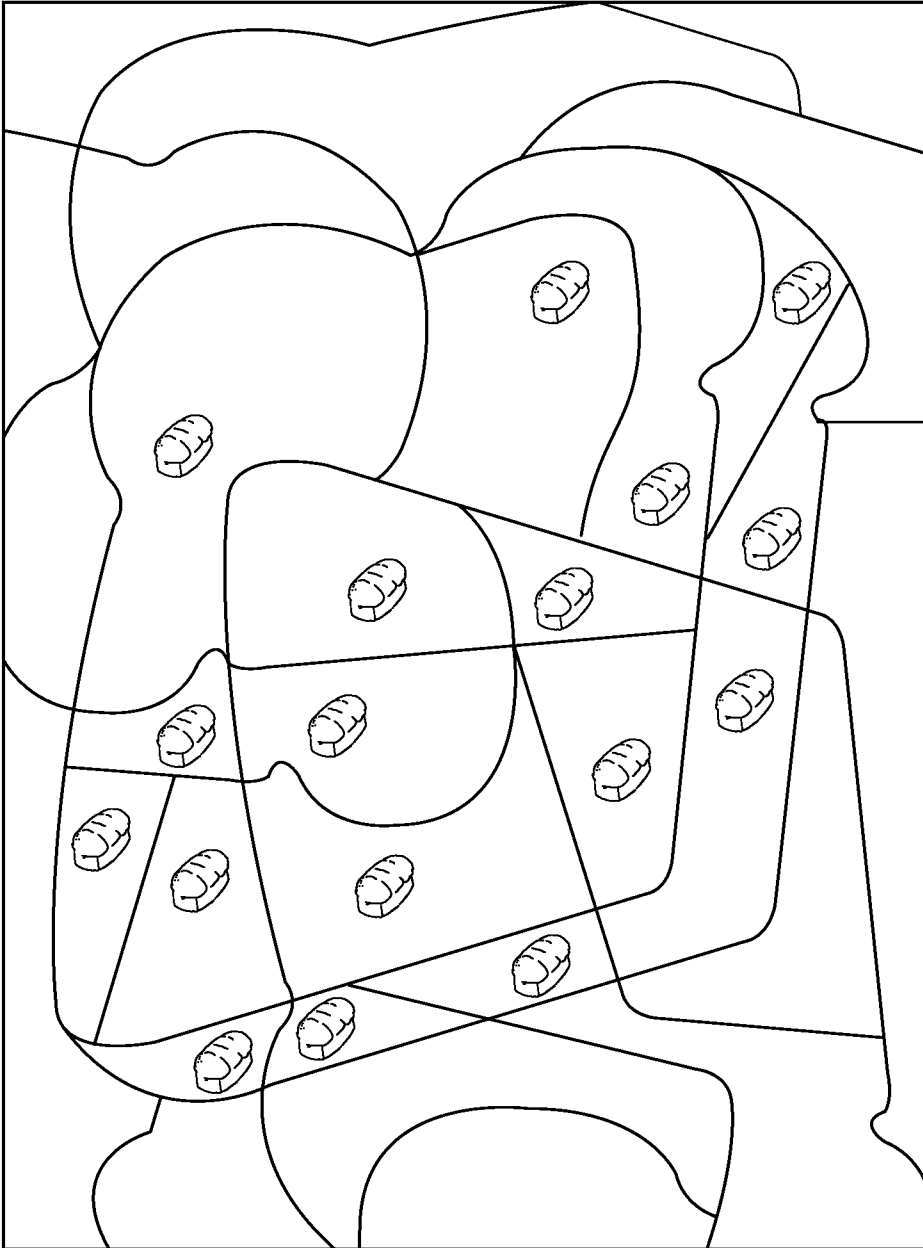
